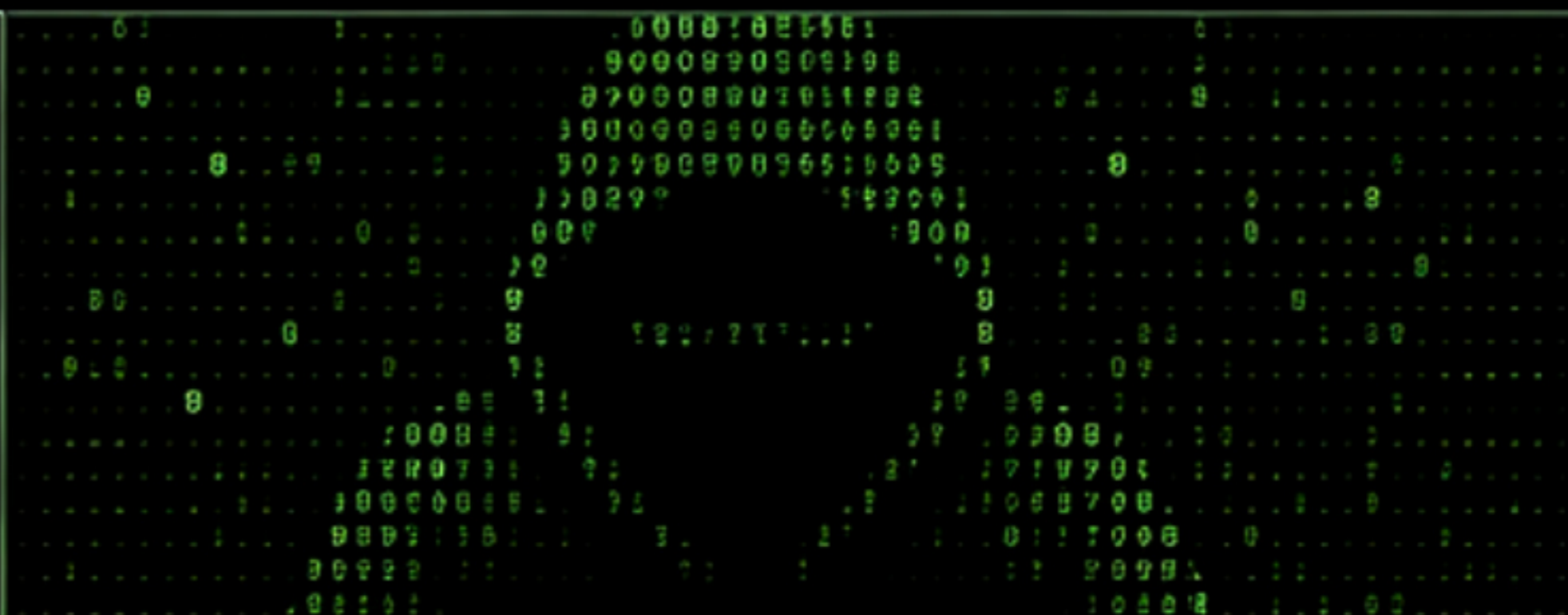


# UNDOXXABLE

A PRACTICAL GUIDE TO REMAINING UNIDENTIFIABLE ONLINE

## 1 MINDSET

	<b>Threat model yourself.</b> Who might want to dox you, and why? What are they capable of?
	<b>Minimize exposure.</b> Don't share unnecessary details. OPSEC starts with what you don't post.
	<b>Assume everything is public.</b> Act like all data is permanent and searchable.
	<b>Compartmentalize.</b> Separate identities, devices, accounts, and activities.

## 2 DIGITAL HYGIENE

	Use strong, unique passwords with a password manager.		Disable telemetry & syncing. Turn off data collection in OS, browsers, and apps.
	Enable 2FA everywhere. Use hardware keys (YubiKey) where possible.		Clear metadata. Strip EXIF from images and documents.
	Keep software updated. Patch OS, browsers, and apps regularly.		Use secure communication. Signal for messaging. PGP for email.
	Use privacy-respecting services. Proton, Mullvad, Signal, Bitwarden, etc.		Verify links & files. Avoid phishing and malicious attachments.

## 3 IDENTITY SEPARATION

<p><b>ALIAS MANAGEMENT</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use consistent aliases per persona.</li> <li>Never reuse usernames across contexts.</li> <li>Avoid variations that link back to you.</li> </ul>	<p><b>EMAIL SECURITY</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use alias email providers.</li> <li>Don't use personal email anywhere.</li> <li>Disable email previews and remote content.</li> </ul>	<p><b>PHONE SECURITY</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Don't use your real number.</li> <li>Use VoIP or burner numbers.</li> <li>Never link social accounts to your number.</li> </ul>	<p><b>SOCIAL MEDIA DISCIPLINE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Don't post personal info or real-life connections.</li> <li>Avoid geotags and location check-ins.</li> <li>Don't engage in identity-revealing behavior.</li> </ul>	<p><b>PAYMENTS &amp; FINANCE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use privacy-focused payment methods.</li> <li>Avoid linking real identity to transactions.</li> <li>Use crypto with OPSEC (see §5).</li> </ul>	<p><b>DEVICES &amp; ACCOUNTS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use separate devices for separate identities.</li> <li>Don't mix accounts on the same browser/profile.</li> <li>Log out and clear sessions.</li> </ul>
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## 4 NETWORK ANONYMITY

	<b>Use Tor for anonymity.</b> Route traffic through Tor Browser. Never log in to personal accounts.
	<b>Use a VPN (no-logs).</b> Mullvad, IVPN, or other audited providers. Never rely on free VPNs.
	<b>Avoid IPv6 leaks.</b> Disable IPv6 or ensure it's routed through VPN/Tor.
	<b>Block trackers &amp; ads.</b> Use uBlock Origin, Brave, or privacy-focused DNS.


## 5 CRYPTO OPSEC

	<b>Don't KYC.</b> Avoid exchanges that require identity verification.
	<b>Use privacy coins.</b> Monero > Zcash > Bitcoin (for privacy).
	<b>Break address linkability.</b> Use new addresses, coin mixing with caution, or decentralized exchanges.
	<b>Secure your wallets.</b> Use hardware wallets and strong passphrases.

## 6 PHYSICAL OPSEC

	<b>Protect your devices.</b> Full-disk encryption, strong lock screens.
	<b>Beware of cameras &amp; mics.</b> Tape over cameras, disable mics when not in use.
	<b>Control your environment.</b> Be aware of who can see or hear you.
	<b>Don't carry links.</b> Avoid items, receipts, or cards that reveal identities.

## 7 THINGS THAT DOXX YOU

- > Real name, photos, addresses, or ID docs
  - > Reused usernames or email addresses
  - > Personal stories, dates, or life events
  - > Friends & family connections
  - > Location data (GPS, Wi-Fi, EXIF)
  - > Public records & data broker leaks
  - > Social engineering
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## 8 DAILY CHECKLIST

- Use VPN or Tor for sensitive activities
- Don't reuse identifiers across contexts
- Check privacy settings on all accounts
- Review and revoke app permissions
- Clear cookies, cache, and metadata
- Verify 2FA and account recovery info
- Search your handles and names regularly
- Stay informed and adapt

## REMEMBER

Perfect anonymity doesn't exist. The goal is to make it expensive, time-consuming, and uncertain to reveal who you are.
