

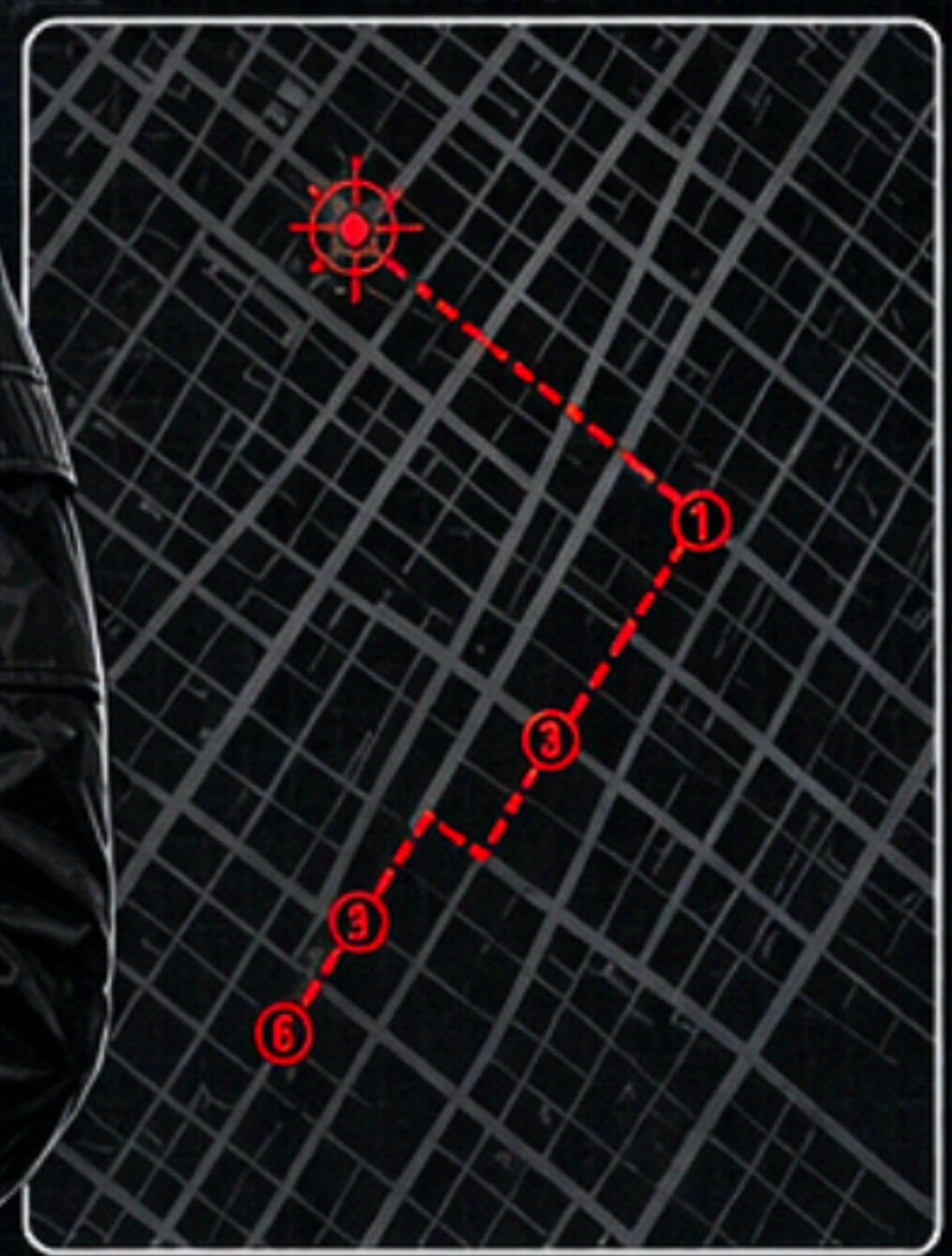
SDR

SURVEILLANCE DETECTION ROUTE

A proactive route designed to detect, confirm, and avoid hostile surveillance before any move.

CORE PRINCIPLES

- OBSERVE FIRST**
 - Always be aware of your surroundings before you act.
- CONTROL THE ROUTE**
 - You choose the path, not your adversary.
- REDUCE PATTERNS**
 - Unpredictability breaks surveillance and keeps you safe.
- CONFIRM FREEDOM**
 - Don't assume you're clear—verify before committing.

01 WHAT IT IS

- A controlled route built to create observation opportunities.
- It adds time, distance, and decision points.
- Its purpose is detection, not drama.

02 WHY IT WORKS

- Surveillance must stay with you through changing conditions.
- Route changes force repeated exposure.
- Patterns emerge when the same person or vehicle reappears.

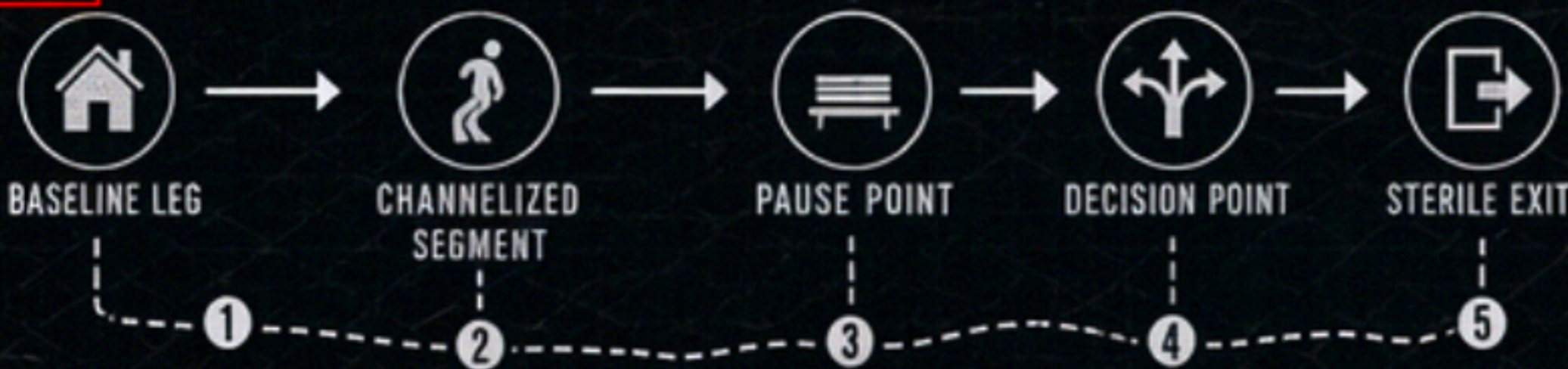
03 WHEN TO USE

- Before meeting or entering sensitive locations.
- When you suspect you are being followed.
- During high-risk movements or counter-surveillance.

04 MINDSET

- Calm, patient, observant.
- You are not hiding—you are collecting data.
- Your best tools are time, awareness, and discipline.

05 ROUTE STRUCTURE



Build friction into the route without breaking cover.

07 DECISION MATRIX

1	✓	NO REPEATS — likely clear.
2	⚠	ONE ANOMALY — continue and collect more data.
3	🔗	TWO LINKED ANOMALIES — assume possible surveillance.
4	🎯	CONFIRMED PATTERN — abort the objective and move safe.

THREAT INDICATOR

- LOW** (Green circle) Proceed
- CAUTION** (Yellow circle) Increase Observation
- HIGH** (Orange circle) Assume Surveillance
- CRITICAL** (Red circle) Disengage Immediately

08 EXECUTION RULES

- Maintain a normal cover story and appearance.
- Use natural pauses, not theatrical maneuvers.
- Observe through reflections, glass, and layered sight lines.
- Note clothing, gait, vehicle type, and plate fragments.
- Do not confront. If risk rises, disengage and report.

09 PED VS VEHICLE

PEDESTRIAN

- Use crossings, entries, and pauses to test continuity.
- Watch who arrives when you arrive.
- Change elevation and direction gradually.

VEHICLE

- Use turns, loops, and stops to test persistence.
- Watch for the same car across separated legs.
- Avoid predictable routes and routines.

14:12 Coffee shop
Male, hoodie
Dark sedan parked.

14:37 Turned left on 3rd Ave.
Same vehicle behind.

15:05 Paused at bench
Same person across street.

15:21 Entered garage
Same vehicle 2 cars behind.

- Record time, place, direction, and repeat identifiers.
- Small details matter more than certainty.
- The route is a diagnostic tool, not a stunt.
