RECON

Gather information



INFILTRATE

Gain access undetected



OBTAIN INTEL

Acquire the target data



EXFILTRATE

Leave the area safely



COVER TRACKS

Remove evidence

DISCIPLINED SEQUENCE // CONTROLLED OUTCOME

01 RECON



Map the target, identify patterns, cameras and entry points.

02 INFILTRATE



Enter through a low-visibility access point.

03 OBTAIN INTEL



Secure the data package.

04 EXFILTRATE



Exit via the planned route before patrols rotate.

05 COVER TRACKS



Remove physical and digital traces.

OUTCOME

MISSION SUCCESS

- ✓ Objective completed
- ✓ No detection
- ✓ Clean exit
- ✓ Intelligence secured
- ✓ Position preserved

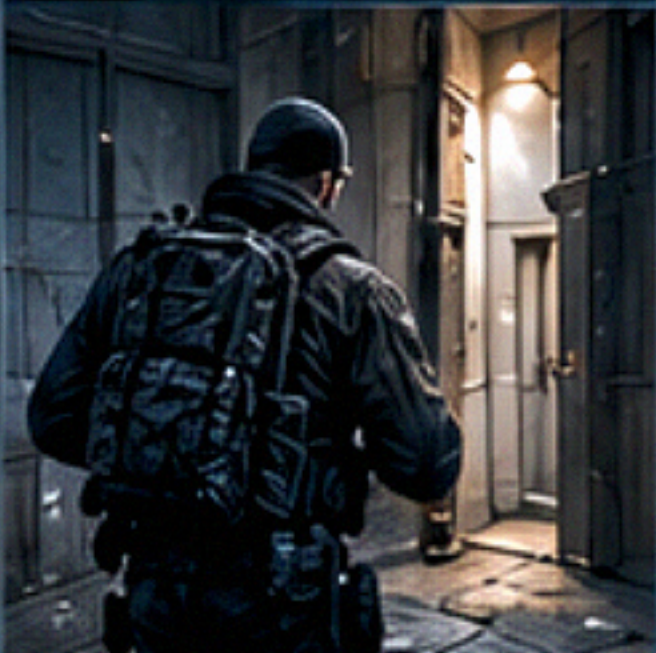

DISORDERED SEQUENCE // COMPROMISED OUTCOME

01 INFILTRATE



Enter without fully mapping the environment.

02 OBTAIN INTEL



Grab the data quickly.

03 RECON



Now assess the area — too late. Patrols are already adjusting.

04 COVER TRACKS



Attempt to clean traces, but activity has been noticed.

05 EXFILTRATE



Exit under pressure. Increased chance of detection.

OUTCOME

MISSION COMPROMISED

- ✗ Detected by surveillance
- ✗ Pursuit initiated
- ✗ Intel at risk
- ✗ Traces remain
- ✗ Future operations affected
